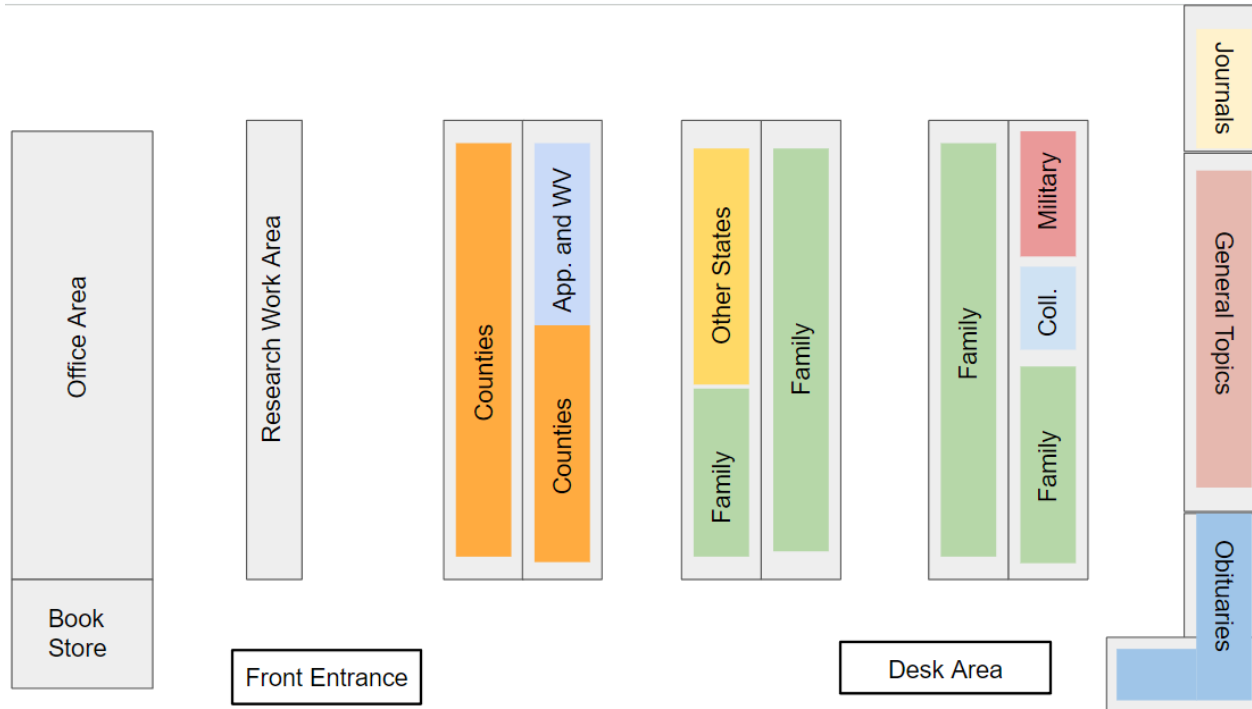


Finding Things In the Library

Family Items are arranged numerically.

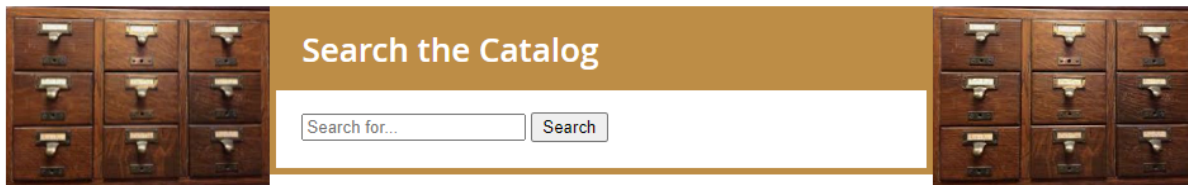
Surname keywords are included in the catalog to help you discover which books will be most helpful to you.

App. = Appalachia
WV = Items about more than one specific county.
COLL = Collections which are still in the process of being cataloged completely. Any changes will be reflected in the catalog

General Topics Include:
IM = Immigration/Emigration
IN = Indians
MI = Miscellaneous
ML = Military
REF = General Genealogy Materials
REL = Denominations and Religious Organizations
ROY = Royalty
SI = Scots-Irish

Finding Things in the Catalog



You will find the catalog on the HCPD Website: <https://www.hackerscreek.org/Library-Catalog>

In the search box, enter a term to search for (Surname, place, event, type of information) Items which include that term will come up in a list. Each item will include the following:

- Title
- Author
- Tags - otherwise known as keywords
- Call Number (the location in the library)

- Many items are available only in the library
- Some items are available only Online - these will have a call number of Online - and a link to the resource
- Some items are available both ways - so you will get a Call Number AND a Link

Your search will bring back:

- A list of items with **any** of the words in the title, author, or tag fields
- Call Number where the book can be found
- Click on the title to bring up other information such as a link to online items.
